



School Counseling Internship

The School Counseling Internship occurs during the final year of the program

Required Time:

- 600 hours total (~300 hours per semester)

Required Experiences:

1. Participate in implementation of a comprehensive guidance program, with varied duties that include system support of the school and the district.
2. Meet with students individually and/or in a group setting to help with personal growth, career planning, or academic interventions.
3. Participation in school counseling activities that promote knowledge and understanding of the eight competency standards set by TSPC.

Required Support/Evaluation:

1. School Site Supervisor role:
 - The site supervisor must provide at least 1 hour per week (or more) of supervision with the intern. That supervision should consist of providing clear and specific feedback on candidate's performance with suggestions for improvement.
 - Assess School Counselor's competency each semester, including completing necessary documentation.
2. NCU field supervisor's role:
 - Participate in initial informational conference with School Counseling candidate and Site Supervisor
 - Conduct two formal observations of School Counselor candidate
 - Collaborate with Site Supervisor on evaluation.
