* All students must take an approved Diversity course. Courses listed in the Diversity Studies menu may also fulfill requirements in other areas of the general education core.

Northwest Christian University accepts the **Associate of Arts Oregon Transfer Degree** as meeting the general education requirements, with the exception of 8 semester (12 quarter) credits of Bible & Christian Ministry, and possibly some electives. All coursework must be college level, generally the 100-level or higher (WR 115 does not transfer). To enter with junior class standing, the student must have at least 60 semester (90 quarter) transferable hours with a grade of C- or higher.

NOTES:

1. Vocational/technical courses are not recommended because they may not transfer if they don't meet graduation requirements.
2. After application to the college, all students will receive a transcript evaluation before the first term of attendance. The application fee is non-refundable.
3. Students transferring with less than 36 quarter units of college work must qualify for admissions on the basis of both their high school and college records, and SAT or ACT test scores may also be required.
4. Only coursework with a "C-" or better will be accepted.
5. Only college level courses (generally those with letter prefixes and numbers above 100) are accepted at Northwest Christian University (WR 115 is not transferable).
