* A minimum of 2 semester (3 quarter) hours are required in EACH of the areas of US/American History and US/American Literature or Political Science

***All students must take an approved Diversity course. The courses listed in the Diversity Studies menu above also fulfill requirements in other areas of the general education core.

1. Northwest Christian University accepts the **AAOT** as meeting the general education requirements, with the exception of 8 semester (12 quarter) credits of Bible & Christian Ministry, and possibly electives. All coursework must be college level, generally 100-level or higher (WR 110 does not transfer). To enter with junior class standing, the student must have at least 60 semester (90 quarter) transferable hours with a grade of C- or higher.
2. Vocational/technical courses are not recommended because they may not transfer if they don't meet graduation requirements.
3. After application to the college, all students will receive a transcript evaluation before the first term of attendance. The application fee is non-refundable.
4. Students transferring with less than 24 semester (36 quarter) units of college work must qualify for admissions on the basis of both their high school and college records, and SAT or ACT test scores may also be required.
5. Only coursework with a C-or better will be accepted.
6. References (including two personal and one academic) are required for admission to Northwest Christian University.
